

The Place de la Bourse (formerly Place Royale, 18<sup>th</sup> century), Saint-Pierre area,  
The old city gate Porte Cailhau (15<sup>th</sup> century)  
The Grosse Cloche or Great Bell gate (former belfry of the town hall),  
The Palais Rohan and the Cathedral

**Discover the “Bassin d’Arcachon”**

Participants meet at « Bordeaux Convention Centre »  
Departure by bus to the “Bassin d’Arcachon”



Visit Europe’s tallest dune, the Dune du Pyla. Accessible by stairs.

From its peak at 115m, it offers an exceptional, panoramic view on the Atlantic Ocean, Arcachon Bay and the vast Landes forest.

Your local guide will share with you the history of this unique site.

After visiting the Dune, meet up at the “jetée Thiers” (Thiers pier) in Arcachon for a boat tour across the bay.

Navigation around the “île aux oiseaux” (Island of Birds), the cabins built on stilts « cabanes tchanquées » and the oyster parks

Stop at Canon, oyster farming village that is lovingly maintained and protected as a classified site, a picturesque location where the traditional activities of fishing and oyster farming continue today. Raw oyster tasting on the half shell, accompanied by a glass of white wine, at an oyster farm.

Stroll along the steep, cobble-stoned streets of the village, explore the 12<sup>th</sup> century Collegial church, the pleasant square in front of the Monolithic church and the market.

Guests will visit a Saint Emilion **Grand Cru Classé wine estate**. They will learn about the Château, visit the public areas and enjoy a lesson on wine tasting while benefiting from the entertaining commentary of a true wine lover. You will visit the Château's park, vat room and cellars.
